About Social Detoxification

Research shows that upwards of 90% of people can safely withdraw from substances without medical intervention. However, most people do not complete this task on their own due to being in unsafe environments, lacking support, lacking coping skills, overwhelming cravings, and the fear of withdrawal.

At Great Lakes Recovery Centers, we provide a Social Detoxification program in which we maintain a safe, supportive environment where we teach and encourage people to use coping skills. Our staff are trained to help coach people through cravings, fears, and withdrawal symptoms that otherwise lead people back to using. While many clients bring withdrawal medications to help ease symptoms, our primary focus is to help people get through this difficult time by changing their attitude, outlook, and behaviors as opposed to relying on substances.

By having our Social Detoxification program embedded within our residential treatment program, we cut out barriers such as transportation and problems with continuity of services so that it is easier for people to enter into residential treatment.



Admission Procedure

A person interested in services needs to be cleared by a physician. Either their own physician or an emergency department physician needs to provide discharge paperwork stating that person is medically stable enough to withdraw in a social detoxification program. It is also expected that the physician will prescribe medications for withdrawal as necessary. Medical personnel, clients, friends or family may contact one of the locations below to learn more about their specific program:

Our staff will complete a brief screening with the person to determine appropriateness for admission. If accepted, our staff will review transportation options.

Criteria For Admission

To be appropriate for admission, a person must meet the following criteria:

- ◆ Be displaying withdrawal symptoms from alcohol or opioids/opiates
- ◆ Be able to safely withdraw from these substances in a non-medical setting
- ◆ Coherent/capable of providing informed consent & completing admission paperwork

Goals

Our goal of social detoxification is twofold. The first goal is to help people safely withdraw from substances. The second, and perhaps most important, is to help people get admitted into a treatment program after detox.
