Men's New Hope House



Residential treatment, sub-acute detoxification and relapse prevention services for men.

Gender Specific Treatment for Men

Men's New Hope House has been offering comprehensive, structured residential treatment services specifically geared to men for over thirty years. Our staff members are certified specialists trained in recognizing the individual conditions of our clients and their families.

Treatment varies from 30 to 120 days. We also offer 14 to 21-day relapse prevention stays.



Personalized Recovery Services

Individualized Treatment Planning

Each resident is assigned a counselor who provides one-on-one service and meets frequently with them throughout their entire stay. Residents identify their personal strengths, support systems and other resources that they will need in order to live in recovery.

Transitional Planning

We help clients establish, in advance, the support services that they'll need when they return home. That includes recovery meetings, employment, housing, family support, public assistance applications and medical and/or behavioral health follow-up care.

Individual and Group Therapy

Group therapy takes place every day of the week. Clients focus on learning and putting in into practice effective life and recovery-related skills.

Our group programs include:

- Relapse Prevention
- Physiology of Addiction
- Life and Communication Skills Development
- Emotional Management Processing
- Pharmacotherapy/Physiology
- Dialectical Behavioral Therapy (DBT)
- Motivational Enhancement
- Anger and Recovery Management

Social Detoxification Services

We offer specialized services to medically stable clients as they withdraw from alcohol or drugs. Our staff members help them attain sobriety and recommend appropriate follow-up treatment.

These services include:

- Intensive individual attention and counseling
- Variable length of stay
- Oversight by medical personnel
- A partnership with War Memorial hospital to ensure that each client has access to the level of care that they need.
- Medication management
- Step-down care

12 Step Support Group

Our program supports the twelve-step recovery movement and meetings are held several times each week at the Men's New Hope House.
