## Basic Manufacturing Skills for Returning Citizens

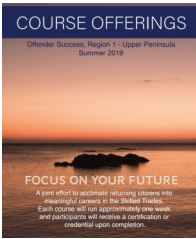


On July 8th, Bay College Training & Development in Escanaba began offering non-credit intensive skills based training that prepares students for entry-level positions with regional manufacturers.

Of the 8 participants, 5 were Offender Success Returning Citizens!!! The 40 hour training covered such topics as Blueprint Reading, Shop Math, Geometric Dimensioning and Tolerancing (GD&T) and Metrology. Students were provided a certificate upon completion and were connected to local employers for job opportunities.

Funding was provided through Michigan Rehabilitation Services - Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) funds.

During the week of August 5th - 8th, Region 1 Offender Success Returning Citizens are set to begin a Career Exploration Camp on the campus of Northern Michigan University in Marquette.
