Great Lakes Recovery Centers Services in L'Anse

L'Anse, MI: Great Lakes Recovery Centers, Inc. (GLRC) continues to serve people in Baraga County and beyond with the Ripple Recovery Residence in L'Anse, as well as the L'Anse Outpatient Services location.

The Ripple Recovery Residence is a home for women who are living in recovery from a substance use disorder. Women living at the house receive case management, attend weekly self-help meetings, work within the community and continue to focus on their sobriety. The house first opened in February of 2020 and welcomed 47 women into the community between February of 2020 and September of 2022.

GLRC is happy to introduce Alyssa Van as the new Ripple Recovery Case Manager. Van has always wanted to help others and has had a passion for serving individuals with substance use disorder. 'I am passionate because of my dad,' said Van. 'He worked with people with substance use disorder most of my life.' Van's own struggles with substance use and mental health, gives her even more purpose to fill her new role at GLRC. Van is excited to help people get the resources that they need to succeed and she hopes to bring more cultural activities to the house.

GLRC also has an Outpatient Services location in L'Anse, providing community members with mental health and substance use disorder counseling.
