GLRC's Negaunee Integrated Care Clinic combines outpatient integrated care and medical services in one conveniently located campus in Negaunee, MI and offers a variety of services to the general public. To schedule a first appointment, call the GLRC Access Center at (906) 228-9696.

Outpatient Services

Outpatient Integrated Care at GLRC offers a flexible, therapeutic approach to treatment in an outpatient manner. Substance use and mental illness are treatable disorders. Millions of people are in lifelong recovery. Troubled families and individuals can and do heal.

Mental Health Services

Mental Health Services clinicians are trained to recognize and personalize a treatment plan for adults, adolescents, and children troubled by anxiety or depression, stress conflicts or relationship difficulties, trauma or abuse (PTSD), attention, conduct, and educational issues, sexual disorders and addiction, and other issues.

Substance Use Disorder Services

Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Services provide flexible, comprehensive treatment options for individuals struggling with SUD. These services include assessments, individual counseling services, links to community resources including Alcoholics and Narcotics Anonymous, Court and DMV assessments, and services specifically designed form women and families.

Child & Adolescent Psychiatric Specialty Clinic

The Child & Adolescent Psychiatric Specialty Clinic helps address the unmet need for psychiatric mental health services for children and adolescents ages 5 through 18 dealing with mild to moderate mental health issues. GLRC has partnered with Pine Rest Christian Mental Health Services to provide psychiatric oversight. Consideration is given for more adverse conditions through screening.

Opioid Health Home

Michigan's Opioid Health Home (OHH) provides comprehensive care management and coordination services to Medicaid beneficiaries with opioid use disorder. Beneficiaries will work with an interdisciplinary team of providers to develop an individualized recovery care plan to best manage their care.

Medication Assisted Treatment

GLRC's Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) clinic provides a combination of counseling services and medication that can help control cravings and the chemical impacts of substances.

Medical Services

Medical Programs are staffed by Physicians, Nurse Practitioners, and nursing staff who may provide medical care. Our services include, minor injury and illness, routine physicals, Women's health, Family Practice, Family Planning, Dermatology, Hepatitis C treatment, Medication Assisted Treatment, and Ostomy Care.

Great Lakes Recovery Centers is licensed by the State of dichigan and accredited by CARF (Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities). GLRC is also HIPAA (Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act) compliant. GLRC actively protects the confidentiality and privacy of their clients.

Foster Care
