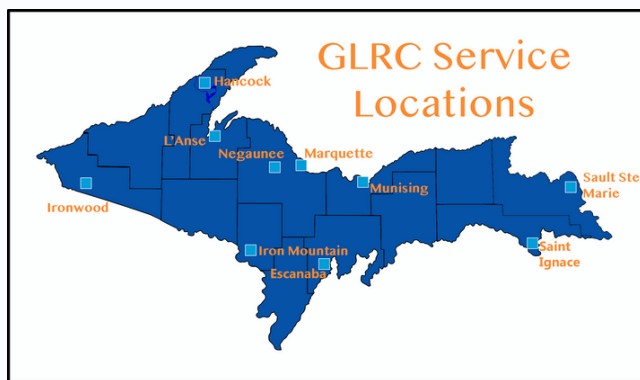

# Opioid Home Health

## About OHH

The Opioid Home Health (OHH) is a program that consists of an interdisciplinary team of providers that help to coordinate, support, and assist individuals who have been diagnosed with an Opioid Use Disorder.

The OHH program is open to any GLRC client with Medicaid, regardless of primary coverage or secondary coverage. The OHH program may consist of any combination of services including medical, mental health, substance use disorder, peer recovery, and community resource services to provide person-centered care.

## Opioid Health Home Treatment Team

The treatment team is made up of the following:

- Client and support system, as invited by client
- Behavioral Health Specialist (Counselor/Therapist)
- Peer Recovery Coach
- Medical Consultant
- Psychiatric/Addiction Consultant

The nurse care manager develops a plan of care to meet each individual's needs and will regularly meet with the team to coordinate and implement the care and needs of clients.

## Services Offered

GLRC offers a variety of services to all clients of the OHH program including:

### Outpatient Counseling

Client's using OHH services have the option of utilizing outpatient counseling services for both mental health and substance use disorders.

### Case Management & Care Coordination

The case manager will work with the client to identify behavioral and physical health needs along with identification of goals for treatment.

### Medical Services

GLRC Medical Services are offered in a variety of locations throughout the Upper Peninsula. These programs are staffed by physicians and nurse practitioners who can provide medication assisted treatment along with treatment for health conditions, preventative care, education on health topics, and minor office procedures. Days and times of availability depend upon the location, however, the medical staff are also available via the use of telehealth services in some locations.

### Peer Support

Peer Recovery Coaches are able to assist the client with community based support and services, along with advocating for client needs, and assisting the client to integrate into the community. Peer Recovery Coaches offer flexible scheduling and offer accessibility to clients outside of business hours.

# Other Services

GLRC offers a wide variety of behavioral health services across our locations. Other services provided by the agency include:

## OS Reentry Services

GLRC works with returning parolees in the UP to assist with the transition back into the community through our program of resources and case management services. For more information call (906) 458-0616.

## Peer Recovery Services

## Recovery Housing

Recovery housing provides structure and support for those living in recovery and allows a safe environment for individuals to continue to heal from the impacts of addiction. For more information call (906) 228-9696.

## Residential Treatment

Clients in residential substance use treatment live in a therapeutic environment alongside other clients with 24-hour supervision and access to on-site clinicians. For more information call (906) 228-9696.

## Veterans Services

GLRC provides readjustment counseling services and a specialized group for veterans in the community. GLRC also works closely with the VA to provide homeless veterans with a place to stay. For more information call (906) 458-2347.

## Outpatient Services

Outpatient services are the first option for those seeking counseling, but need the freedom to continue working or going to school. Outpatient services are also used as follow-up for clients who have completed residential services. For more information call (906) 228-9696.
